

## UNIT 2 - MEMORY & FANTASY

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### EXERCISE 3: WORLD OF COLOR

Supplies:

- Sketchbok
- Paint swatches (10 minimum)
- Glue
- Pencil

Process:

The purpose of this exercise is to observe colors from your surroundings, and recognize ways that color can relate to an object's meaning or purpose. Start at a hardware store, or paint supply store. Collect a minimum of 10 paint chips, with colors in which you respond. Carry these swatches with you over the course of the weekend, attempting to match them to things you find in the real world. Glue the paint swatches in your process-folio / bristol board, and make note of where you found the colors: (i.e Blue Springs #1592 is the color of my favorite cereal bowl / Ginseng Root #386 is the color of my hair / Grassy Meadow #570 is the color of a tennis ball).

Output:

10 Paint chips glued to process-folio, sketchbook, or bristol. For each provide a notation describing what object the color relates.
