

## UNIT 2 - MEMORY & FANTASY

### EXERCISE 2: Complimentary Color Scale > Grays & Neutrals

Supplies:

- Paint
- Tape
- Palette / Palette Knife
- Paint Brush (1/2" flat)
- Water Dish
- Color Wheel
- Sketchbook

Process:

When two complimentary colors are mixed together, chromatic grays and neutrals emerge. Prepare a sheet of bristol board with three 1"x7" rectangles. Divide into 1"x1" cells. Following the diagram below, start with a primary color and its compliment. Mix the subsequent cells as described. Do this three times, once for each primary. The center of the scale should be a neutral gray.
